AfterSchool Adventure – 2010-2011 School Year

AfterSchool Adventure is a Before and After School Care program for District #6 grade school (Grades K-8) kids offered by Zion Park District and Zion Elementary District #6. Games, crafts, special activities, computers, gym time, outdoor play, homework time and a lot more will be planned each week! The program, called AfterSchool Adventure, is held at the Shiloh Center. AfterSchool Adventure is divided into two separate sessions:

AM – 6 a.m. until school begins available for K – 8th Central Jr. High children will walk to school.

*PM – school dismissal until 6 p.m. * K – 6th only
(includes early dismissal days)
